General information on Child Abuse and Neglect and Child Welfare

Crosson-Tower, C. *Understanding Child Abuse and Neglect*, (Boston: Allyn and Bacon, 2005).

(A comprehensive guide to child abuse and neglect and the services offered to parents and children)

Crosson-Tower, C., *Exploring Child Welfare*. (Boston: Allyn and Bacon, 2001).

(A comprehensive survey of child welfare services from supporting the family through counseling and family preservation to substitute services like foster care and adoption).

Crosson-Tower, C. *When Children Are Abused: An Educators Guide to Child Maltreatment*. (Boston: Allyn and Bacon, 2002).

(Designed for teachers in schools, this text gives a basic overview of child abuse and neglect as well as suggesting how teachers can report, and work with children and families after the report. The book also outlines suggestions for developing a school reporting protocol).

Crosson-Tower, C. *From the Eye of the Storm: The Experiences of a Child Welfare Worker* (Boston: Allyn and Bacon, 2002).

(This book reads more like a novel than a text as it chronicles the experiences of a social worker in both adoption and protective services as she outlines her feelings, impressions, and challenges. A must to help other professionals understand the world of social work with children).

Shelman, E.A. and Lazoritz, S. *Out of the Darkness: The Story of Mary Ellen Wilson* (Lake Forest, CA.: Dolphin Moon, 2000).

(This is a fascinating story of the little girl whose experiences put into motion the movement to help abused and neglected children. A very interesting read.)

(This book explores childhood sexuality with an emphasis on how children can be overly sexualized, which children will then molest and what type of treatment will be helpful to them).

Araji, S. K., *Sexually Aggressive Children* (Thousand Oaks, CA.: Sage, 1997).

(A comprehensive overview of sexual abuse by children 12 and younger, this book explores why children abuse and how therapists may treat them).
